## Plenary Roads Denver US 36 Express Lane Update

### Plenary Roads Denver Adjusts Express Lane Rates

*Updates will help manage traffic flow and transition to dynamic tolling*

**Denver, June 24, 2021**— Plenary Roads Denver (PRD) is making adjustments to time-of-day Express Lane tolling rates effective July 11, 2021. These adjustments will allow PRD to better manage traffic flow in the US 36 and I-25 Central Express Lanes during the transition to dynamic Express Lane pricing.

Data from these adjustments will help further develop the dynamic pricing algorithm that will provide real-time rates based on traffic volumes. PRD last adjusted rates in 2018. On average, rates are going up about 7%, mostly during peak travel periods.
