

## Plenary Roads Denver Team Volunteers at Marshall Fire Donation Center

*US 36 operator worked with partners to ensure roadway was safe and passable during and after devastating fire*

**DENVER, Feb. 23, 2022**—Plenary Roads Denver (PRD) team members are volunteering this week to help organize and distribute donations to victims of the Marshall Fire. As part of the fire recovery efforts, PRD worked with the Boulder Office of Emergency Management and was provided the opportunity to volunteer at a donation site at Flatirons Mall.

The center is operated by Adventist Community Services Disaster Relief and A Precious Child. Spark the Change Colorado is providing volunteer management and filling as many as 80 volunteer shifts per day to keep the site open.

The donations site is located in the former Nordstrom, between Dick's Sporting Goods and Macy's. Immediately following the fire, PRD worked with its partners – the [High-Performance Transportation Enterprise](#) (HPTE), the [Colorado Department of Transportation](#) and the [Regional Transportation District](#) – to ensure the roadway remained open and safe for emergency services and residents. PRD operates and maintains US 36 and US 36 express lanes between Denver and Boulder, as well as the I-25 Central Express Lanes.
