Denver, July 1, 2025— Plenary Roads Denver (PRD) is making adjustments to time-of-day Express Lane tolling rates effective July 1, 2025. These adjustments will allow PRD to better manage traffic flow and travel times in the US 36 and I-25 Central Express Lanes.
